

The first two month was eventful at HUNGEXPO. The exhibition season was opened on 23 January by the most important agricultural industry event in Hungary. Nearly **350 exhibitors** present their products and services in the field of input-mechanization-logistics on **40,000 square meters**. and more than **47,000 visitors** arrived in 4 days. This year, the event was accompanied by more conferences and workshops than ever before, where farmers could get answers to the most current issues in the industry.

**55,000 visitors** were interested in the Carpathian Basin's most prominent fishing, hunting and arms event, where **17 countries** and nearly **300 exhibitors** brought their portfolios between 7-10 February. At the opening of the exhibition they signed the "One with nature" **cooperation agreement** of the World Hunting and Nature Expo 2021 (**Hunting World Exhibition**) and have announced that HUNGEXPO **will be renovated for around 50 billion forints** in the coming years.

The new pairing debuted successfully. The Budapest Boat Show and the Travel exhibition complemented each other perfectly.

**35,000 people** attended the event, which is a great development according to last year. This figure is **25 percent higher** than last year's total visitor number of the two exhibitions. At the 42<sup>nd</sup> **Travel Exhibition, 300 exhibitors from 30 countries** presented themselves. The **Budapest Boat Show**

featured a full range of domestic sailing, motor and electric boats for the 28<sup>th</sup> time. Two pavilions of the exhibition were filled with **83 exhibitors** and **110 ships** together with associated shipping services and equipment.
